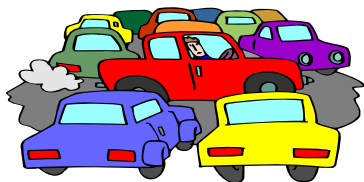

National Drunk and Drugged Driving Prevention Month

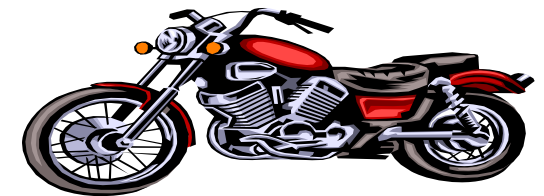
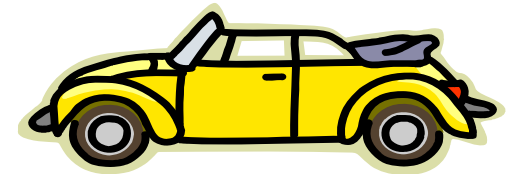

What You Can Do About Impaired Driving

Wear your safety belt and be sure children are properly secured in child safety seats.

Be a responsible host. Don't let your guests drive after drinking alcohol and never serve alcohol to someone under the age of 21.

Write letters to the editor of local newspapers expressing your concern over drunk driving and underage drinking in your community.

Never ride in a car with someone who has been drinking—call a cab or ask a friend to drive you home.

Support measures to strengthen drunk driving

Report drunk drivers immediately. Keep a safe distance from anyone driving erratically and do not try to intervene yourself.
