

What is ERIC? ERIC is the Educational Resources Information Center, a national information system designed to provide users with ready access to an extensive body of education related literature.

Eric documents can have one of two designations attached to their accession number: **EJ** or **ED**. (See the sample document citations on the reverse side).

1. Documents with **EJ numbers** refer to ERIC journal articles and are not on fiche. Check Addison, the online catalog, to see if this library owns the journal. If not owned, you can try to obtain the article through Interlibrary Loan.

2. Documents with **ED numbers** might be found online or on microfiche or both. Documents prior to 1993 will *not* be online and may or may not be available on fiche. Most of the ED numbers are issued on microfiche and are available in the ERIC fiche sections in the Microforms area on the first floor. The fiche are arranged numerically by the ED_____. A few ED numbers are not issued on fiche and therefore not included in the fiche set.

Microfiche printers are available. If you need help locating the ERIC fiche, please ask for assistance at the Reference Desk on the 1st floor.
