United States Congressional Serial Set (Microfiche)

The US Congressional Serial Set is a bound compilation of the reports and documents of the House and Senate. These volumes consist of congressional publications and reports submitted to Congress by other government agencies and commissions. The University Libraries has many of the printed volumes (call number: Docs YCS) and a microfiche collection produced by the Congressional Information Service (CIS). The CIS microfiche collection covers the American State Papers through the 91st Congress, 1st Session, 1789 – 1969.

The CIS U.S. Serial Set microfiche are located in microfiche cabinets labeled CIS U.S. Serial Set.

Microfiche are filed by Congress, session, serial volume number, and document number.

The CIS Congressional Publications microfiche library picks up where the CIS U.S. Serial Set leaves off microficheing and indexing House and Senate hearings, reports, committee prints, and documents, executive reports and treaty documents, special publications and public laws beginning in 1970. Many of these publications are also available in printed copy in the government documents collection.

The microfiche are located in microfiche cabinets labeled CIS.

The microfiche are filed by the date of the index and accession number/CIS Number.

Unpublished U.S. Senate Committee Hearings. (Microfiche)

In the course of research for other CIS publications, researchers became aware that transcripts existed for a large number of hearings that have never been published. The collection represents unpublished hearings from the earliest surviving transcripts from the 18th Congress, 1823, to the 96th Congress, 1980.

The microfiche are located in microfiche cabinets labeled Unpublished U.S. Senate Committee Hearings.
