U.S. War Dept., *War of the Rebellion: A Compilation of the Official Records of the Union and Confederate Armies*. Usually referred to as the "OR". Call no.: E464 U6 Newman

The OR contains the reports and correspondence of the army units. The 127 volume set is divided into four series of volumes, a general index and an atlas.

The four series of the set are:

- Series I: Military Operations
- Series II: Prisoners
- Series III: Union Authorities
- Series IV: Confederate Authorities

Each series contains separate volumes which are in turn sometimes divided into parts.

The citations in the *General Index* refer to series and volume numbers (ex., II, 6). For more specific references and page numbers, turn to the individual indexes in the parts of these volumes.

The *General Index* also includes a synopsis of the contents of volumes, a special index for principal armies, corps, divisions and departments, and a table showing contemporaneous operations.

The *Atlas* (Call no.: E464 U6 Atlas/SPEC) is kept in Special Collections. A reprint, *The Official Atlas of the Civil War* (Call no.: E470 U6 Atlas 1958 Newman/Folio) is shelved in the oversize section of the Newman stacks.

Two CD-ROMs of the *OR* are available, one each at the 2nd floor Reference desk and the Special Collections Reading Room. The version at the 2nd floor Reference desk contains the following books, in addition to the *OR*: *Major Battles in the Official Records*, *A Compendium of the War of the Rebellion*, *Regimental Losses in the American Civil War*, and *A User's Guide to the Official Records of the American Civil War*. Ask for assistance at each desk from library staff.

Military Operations of the Civil War: A Guide-Index to the [OR] (Call no.: E470 U63 Ref Room) is shelved in the Reference Room on the 2nd floor. Included in the guide are "Principal Military Operations by State -- Virginia," "Comprehensive Index -- Virginia," and "Checklist by County and Date -- Virginia." This guide-index is also available on CD-Rom. Again, ask for assistance at the 2nd floor Reference desk.

U.S. War Dept., *Compiled Service Records of Confederate Soldiers Who Served in Organizations from the State of Virginia*. Usually referred to as the CSR. (Call No.: E581.4 C65 Microfilm)

This microfilm collection is composed of copies of the records of individual servicemen as found in the War Department files. These records include enlistments, pay vouchers, paroles, and other types of documents. The last 63 reels of the 1075 total reels contain the index to servicemen's names. To find an individual, look for him and his unit in the index. The microfilm locations of the various units' records can be found by checking the "Pamphlet Accompanying Microcopy No. 324," located on the index table in the Center for Alternative Media (CAM).

SPECIAL COLLECTIONS DEPARTMENT

The Special Collections Department, located on the first floor of Newman Library, holds rare and special books, manuscript collections, historical maps and photographs, and the University Archives. The department actively collects Civil War books and manuscript materials, making it one of the department's most significant collections.

Materials must be looked at in the department reading room, except to be photocopied at library photocopy machines at the discretion of the department staff.

Monographs

Many of the Civil War books in the collection were donated by the late Elden E. Billings of Washington, D.C., who spent his lifetime collecting books on the Battle of Gettysburg, northern regimental histories, and a wide array of other Civil War topics. These books are accessible through the online catalog. Materials in Special Collections are identified by "SPEC," "SPEC/Civil War," "SPEC/Genealogy," "SPEC/Ref," or "Storage/SPEC" after the call number.

Manuscripts

The Special Collections Department also holds hundreds of original Civil War letters, diaries, memoirs, and scrapbooks, published during the war years or soon thereafter. The Civil War manuscript collection is accessible through the department's website at <http://scholar2.lib.vt.edu/spec/civwar/cwhp.htm> and through guides available in the department. Please consult the staff in the Special Collections Department for more information.

Please note that some collections may be stored in the Libraries' off-site storage facility. These materials can be ordered with the help of the department staff and are available in the department usually within two or three working days.

VPI & SU MASTERS' THESES

Copies of Virginia Tech Masters' theses are located through Special Collections, at the off-site storage facility, or the 3rd floor of Newman Library. Call numbers that have a "Storage/SPEC" following it must be ordered through document delivery but can only be looked at in Special Collections, usually within one or two working days after the order is made.

Since 1997, Virginia Tech masters and dissertation students have been required to submit their work to the Electronic Theses and Dissertation (ETD) website. Many

students choose to submit their work in electronic form only, so a monograph of their work may not be available at the stack locations. MONTGOMERY COUNTY AND THE NEW RIVER VALLEY OF VIRGINIA IN THE CIVIL WAR

Montgomery County, where gunpowder was manufactured (near Craig's Creek) for the Confederate army, and where many Confederate soldiers were buried, saw very little heavy action during the war, although it probably seemed real enough to the residents. Though the Battle of Cloyd's Farm near Dublin in May 1864 cannot be considered a major battle, it was an important engagement because it was part of the Federal design to destroy the Virginia and Tennessee Railroad, which had a depot and warehouse in Dublin. The line of Federal retreat from Cloyd's Farm was through Christiansburg, Blacksburg, (where the Federal Forces spent three days), Newport, and over the mountains into West Virginia. A final engagement in Montgomery County, which occurred after Lee had surrendered, was the Battle of Seven Mile Tree, near Ingles Ferry, on April 12, 1865.
