

Find Books To locate books and other materials in the library on digital art and design, try doing some SUBJECT SEARCHES in ADDISON (VT's online library catalog) using the following phrases:

- image processing -- digital techniques

- type and type-founding -- digital techniques

Find Articles Here is a *selected* list of library-provided databases that contain citations and possibly full-text articles related to digital art and design (Available to VA Tech community only). To access these databases from the University Library's homepage (<http://www.lib.vt.edu>) click on the "articles/databases" link.

Interlibrary Loan If you want to obtain an article or conference proceeding that the University Libraries do not own, try requesting the item from Interlibrary Loan/ILLIAD [http://www.ill.vt.edu/](http://www.ill.vt.edu) You can request many other types of items not owned by the University Libraries, including books, videos, and thesis/dissertations.

- **Art Full Text:** Citations back to 1984, with full text as far back as 1997. Subjects include antiques, archaeology, architecture & architectural history, art history, contemporary art, costume, crafts, decorative arts, folk art, graphic arts, industrial design, interior design, landscape architecture, motion pictures, non-western art, painting, photography, pottery, sculpture, television, textiles, video art, etc. Try searching using some of the terms listed above under "Find Books", in addition to: ELECTRONIC ART.
- **Bibliography of the History of Art (BHA):** The Bibliography of the History of Art indexes and abstracts articles, art-related books, conference proceedings, dissertations, and art exhibition and dealer's catalogs. This extensive and comprehensive index covers European and American art from late antiquity to the present.
- **Grove Dictionary of Art Online (full-text):** The Dictionary of Art offers over 45,000 full-text signed articles on a vast range of visual arts and architecture topics from prehistory through the present. The Dictionary of Art is a great place to start for an introduction to VIDEO ART, CONCEPTUAL ART, and profiles of artists working in DIGITAL media. Link from "reference databases" under Online Resources. (Also available in print: N6847 G758 2000 ART/ARCH REF)
- **InfoTrac OneFile (includes full-text):** Comprehensive coverage of all the InfoTrac databases from one interface, including five major newspapers, 89 newswires, general interest periodicals and refereed academic journals. Try doing SUBJECT GUIDE searches using the following phrases: COMPUTER ART, ART AND TECHNOLOGY, VIDEO ART, and COMPUTER ANIMATION.

Journals & Design Annuals: This is a *selected* list of publications that have good coverage of digital/new media art that the University Libraries currently receive.
